In Malmö the 3rd – 4th of November 2021, a very special conference called *Against firearm-related violence in Sweden* will take place.

This conference brings together both Swedish and international researchers, practitioners, politicians, the police, authorities, non-profit organizations, local initiatives and other parties. The purpose is to share knowledge and successful methods and innovative ideas in order to seek solutions to reduce and work against the firearm-related violence in Sweden.

As part of promoting innovative ideas and solutions, we invite college and university students to contribute with your ideas on how we can work against firearm-related violence. Maybe you have an idea that decision-makers in the Government, the Swedish Parliament and municipalities should know about? This is the chance to kickstart that idea!

How to participate:

Send us:

- A description of idea on how to best reduce firearm-related violence in Sweden: What is it about, which actors in society should be involved and what effects would it have? Why do you think you're your project could work?
 - Your name and contact information where we can reach you.
 - A list of references to cited research, articles etc.
- The project may be a **maximum of 3 A4 pages** (12p).
 - Submit your project by emailing project manager Yi-Wen Chen, yi-wen.chen@piku.se. You may do this **no later than 31 August**, but preferably earlier.

During October, a jury of members of the conference reference group, among others, will read through the entries for the competition and **nominate three entries** that will be presented during the conference dinner. The students behind the nominated projects will receive an award and participate at the conference for free, including a three-course dinner on the evening of November 3rd. The conference is a chance to make unique contacts with researchers, practitioners, experts and politicians - contacts that can take you on exciting paths!
